Students will design and make a working robot to meet a series of challenges (walk, talk, dance, jump, fly) in order to demonstrate their understanding of robotics and artificial intelligence. The robots created will be automatically entered into the Korean Robotics competition. The students will explain how their robots work in detail and answer questions about their robots and win prizes. Students are motivated to learn by creating their own robotic devices, while at the same time gain a deeper understanding of interdisciplinary fields of study. In addition, robotics appeals to a broad range of students and allows multiple points of access to science and technology for a variety of learners. Students will build their own robot that will be supplied and theirs to keep.

(Intermediate/ Advanced)

As part of Dwight's Extra-Curricular Program, "SAT Prep Program" is offered. Reading requires both reading skills and strategies and techniques to solve the questions. Our aim is for students to be more successful in testing format such as PSATs, SATs. Reading skill will train students to read actively (efficiency in absorption of information), skim read (efficiency in speed) and read selectively depending on text types (efficiency in comprehension through knowledge of basic structures of science, history, literature texts). The techniques and strategies will focus on understanding what each question type is asking, and how to prevent confusion between answer choices.

“Bouldering” Climbing

Grades 6-8

Bouldering is a form of rock climbing that is performed without the use of ropes or harnesses. Climbing is one of the best total body workouts available. It's a unique sport in which boys and girls are equally capable. The motion of climbing works every part of you. From your fingers and forearms as you grip the rock or climbing hold, your abs and core as you lift your legs into position

then your whole body as you propel yourself up with your legs and pull up with on your arms. Each climbing route is like a puzzle, which takes patience and planning, forcing the climber to make decisions as one gets to a spot and strategizes where to go from there. Climbing requires for you to make spot decisions as you go, commit and follow through. Your ability to assess a problem, look for a solution, and then execute a plan is required. Beginners typically decide their route hold by hold, not looking ahead to see the larger picture in front of them. Soon one begins to visualize a route before grabbing the first hold. With practice, the climber is able to see the entire route in his mind, building his problem solving and planning abilities.

Hatha Yoga

Hatha Yoga It is an ancient practice that dates back to the 1st century. Today it often simply refers to the practice of physical yoga postures. The

word “hatha” can be translated two ways: 1) as “willful” or “forceful,” or the yoga of activity, 2) and as “sun” (ha) and “moon” (tha), the yoga of balance. Health is wealth and good health is a valuable asset to one and all. It can be achieved by the regular practice of Yoga Asanas. The practice of Asanas controls the emotions, produces mental peace, distributes energy evenly throughout the body and different systems, helps in maintaining healthy functioning of the internal organs, gives internal massage to the various abdominal organs. Physical exercises draw the energy out but the Yoga Asanas send the Prana (energy) in. The practice of Asanas cures many diseases and awakens Kundalini Sakti. These are the chief advantages in the Yogic system of exercises which no other systems have. Hatha Yoga will be offered as an ECP on Tuesday afternoons for grades 8 – 12. The practice will support deeper sleep, reduced stress, increased mindfulness, more calmness and easier learning. You will get to develop your own practice that will include: • Breath control and balance • Dynamic warmup exercises • Static calming postures • Mindful relaxation
